20 Workers for God's Kingdom Graduated in June

June 22nd we had good reasons to celebrate and praise the Lord. On that day, 20 graduates of our school received diplomas. 15 graduated with bachelor degrees, 2 from the master program in Theology and 3 finished Studies in the Christian Culture master program. This is a very good addition of workers for God's Kingdom in Estonia. That gives reason for even more encouragement to continue with our HOME of HOPE project as we know that there are people who want to study theology in a Bible-based school and want to proclaim the Word of God in many ways.

Today, we also share information on how our newly graduated

students have used their education and what new steps they have made:

*4 continue their studies in our Master of Theology program and their goal is to become pastors in the Lutheran Church.

*3 continue their studies in our Master of Theology program in the Pastoral Care specialty in order to become pastoral care givers.

*4, even before graduation, are serving as deacons (assistants to pastors) in the Lutheran Church.

*1 is a newspaper correspondent.

*7 are working as pastoral care givers.

*6 are lay leaders in their parish congregations.

34 New Students Were Admitted in August

More good news is that in the end of August we admitted 34 new students: 10 into the bachelor program and 10 into the master of theology program (7 of them just graduated our bachelor program and continue on to pursue the master level). And, it's interesting that 14 new students have begun their studies in the Christian Culture master program. This shows that we have, in Estonia, many people who have gained their education without receiving any knowledge about Christianity. During their life and work they have felt they are missing something and they need to complete their education. That's why it's important to have this educational program.

We are very thankful and humble that God has granted us such a blessing.

Delightful Youth Bible Camp

In Estonia, in co-operation with East European Missions Network and Christians from the United States, English Bible camps for adults have been held since 2006. In August of 2019 we together launched the first Bible camp for youth and it was very fruitful. Ten boys and girls, ages 13-18, attended. The theme of the camp was relationships. That was very meaningful for the youth as they were able to talk about their relationships with Jesus, with their family and with their friends. Afterward, one of the participants confessed to her parents that this camp was the absolute highlight of the summer and she is waiting impatiently for camp in 2020. Not all of the participants were Christians but we pray and hope with confidence that seed was planted into their hearts.

We Became Owners of the HOME of HOPE Facility

September 19th, 2019, Tartu Academy of Theology became the owner of the HOME of HOPE facility. We took out a \$1,300,000 mortgage loan for 5 years with 5% interest and bought the property. The contract has been signed and notarized.

In April of 2018, under God's guidance, we began this project from zero with 100 dollars. Now, 17 months later, we have a property, which in December, will house a unique Christian Outreach Center. We have experienced tremendous blessing and we are blessed by so many good friends who form a great circle of God's ambassadors. **THANK YOU TO ALL OUR DONORS AND PRAYER WARRIORS!** Together we have made the impossible possible. HOME of HOPE is a landmark for Estonian people that is testifying that God is alive.

Please, don't abandon us now, because we have to continue this path for 5 more years until the mortgage loan is paid. Stopping or returning is impossible.

The opening of HOME of HOPE is scheduled for December 2nd, 2019, and you are all welcome to join with us on this glorious day if you are able.
