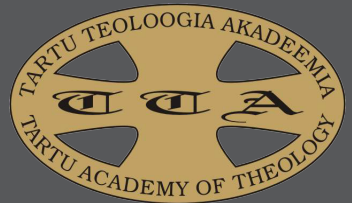

Christian Outreach in Estonia for **GENERATIONS TO COME**

Cooperation with U.S. Government

Christian Radio located at Home of Hope has already been proclaiming the Gospel of Jesus Christ over the airwaves **24/7 for 28 years**. They have 6 studios in Estonia and the studio located at Home of Hope is the main one. Also, the server which sends radio to the air is set up in Home of Hope's server room. Having a radio station in our facility provides a very good opportunity for our students to make radio broadcasts and it's a very easy way for us to advertise our activities and events.

Radio recently entered into very interesting cooperation with the U.S. Government. Family Radio has a Russian broadcast that is sent out through a shortwave transmitter and is reaching deep into Russian territory and also Ukraine. **Since spring, the**

U.S. Government is funding the Radio Liberty broadcast an hour per day through the Family Radio shortwave transmitter.

Shortwave cannot be blocked by the Russian authorities, and therefore with the help of the Family Radio, Radio Liberty reaches Russia and Ukraine.



1-Minute-Bible-Study

We started making a 1-Minute-Bible-Study series in co-operation with Kristjan Luhamets, lead pastor of St. Paul's Lutheran Church of Tartu.

The aim of these videos is to establish some kind of connection with youth on social media platforms and to give them Christian content while they browse.

After covid, when things started to go back to normal, we discovered that not all of the youth had come back. We saw that there was a need for youth work on social media in Estonia and since we position ourselves as partners to churches, it was our duty to find a solution with an innovative position. **We are glad that this format has received a lot of good feedback** and are looking forward to continuing this project, but also accepting new opportunities where God leads us!

Daycare for Ukraine Refugees

Last fall St. Maria's Lutheran Church in Tartu launched a daycare for Ukraine refugees. Most refugees are escaping women with small children. It's a great challenge for them to find a job if they

don't have a safe place for their children. Daycare gives parents some free time and provides an opportunity for children to meet with other Ukraine children.



Laryssa (in the picture), a refugee from Ukraine who is living in Home of Hope's guest apartment, used to be a kindergarten principal and now she is the principal of the daycare.

We have supported this daycare with funds that we have received from our friends from America as donations to support Ukrainians. Unfortunately these funds are depleted and we won't be able to help them anymore.
